The point here is not to point a finger, but to learn that early in the season we need to be even more vigilant in our self-evaluations of how we are diving.

And do not misunderstand me our vigilance needs to be hyper-max at all times.

We are entering an environment that does not sustain life as we enjoy it on the surface. We need to respect Mother Ocean and ourselves in it so dive safe, be present in this very extreme world and dive responsibly.
